

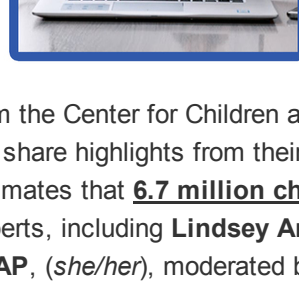

**"Millions of Children May Lose Medicaid: What Can Be Done?"**

Join the Institute for Medicaid Innovation (IMI) for a webinar on what can be done to address the mass Medicaid eligibility redetermination that will occur once the COVID-19 public health emergency lapses. **Joan Alker, M.Phil.** (*she/her*), and **Tricia Brooks, MBA**, (*she/her*), from the Center for Children and Family at Georgetown University's McCourt School of Public Policy will share highlights from their February 2022 report, Millions of Children May Lose Medicaid, which estimates that **6.7 million children are at-risk for becoming uninsured**. ### CDPS + Rx Project Update: ICD-10 Codes Crosswalk Available

As you are aware, we are currently working on an update to the CDPS + Rx model to be released this summer. In the meantime, IMI, in partnership with our colleagues at UCSD, has developed an updated ICD-10 code crosswalk that includes 191 ICD-10 codes that will be included in the updated CDPS + Rx model, but that were introduced after releasing CDPS + Rx version 6.5. 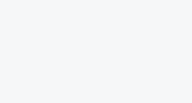
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
