#### Complete IMI's 5th Annual Medicaid MCO Survey

Medicaid health plans can now complete the <u>annual Medicaid MCO survey</u>! The survey was developed in partnership with Medicaid health plan representatives, researchers, and policymakers with the primary goal of equipping stakeholders with data to accurately depict the national narrative on Medicaid managed care. Submit completed surveys by **March 14, 2022.** 

#### CDPS + Rx Project Update: ICD-10 Codes Crosswalk Available

As you are aware, we are currently working on an update to the CDPS + Rx model to be released this summer. In the meantime, IMI, in partnership with our colleagues at UCSD, has developed an updated ICD-10 code crosswalk that includes 191 ICD-10 codes that will be included in the updated CDPS + Rx model, but that were introduced after releasing CDPS + Rx version 6.5. This crosswalk is available to
