Results from the 2021 Annual Medicaid Health Plan Survey are Released

Funded by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, IMI's 2021 Medicaid Health Plan Survey Report provides an annual look at trends shaping Medicaid managed care organizations. In 2020, 95% of Medicaid health plans committed to transition to telehealth, and 70% of health plan respondents reported having a health equity plan. Now in its fourth year, the survey offers a comprehensive overview of the value Medicaid managed care contributes to members' health and the U.S. health care system. Impact of COVID-19 on Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program

A recent IMI analysis of the National Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (NBCCEDP) found that more than half of states experienced an increase in eligibility for both breast cancer screening (32 states) and cervical cancer screening (31 states) through the NBCCEDP from 2019 to 2020. The analysis, conducted through support from the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN), focused on both state and national level shifts in program eligibility for individuals by screening categories including race and ethnicity, Medicaid expansion status.
